This publication is sponsored by the Arkansas Valley Audubon Society (AVAS). Its scope covers the following Colorado counties: Pueblo, Fremont, Custer, Huerfano, Otero, Crowley, and Las Animas. Systematic research of bird distribution in the Pueblo Area was begun by a few enthusiastic birders in the 1960s. This checklist is the work of many, thanks to the rapidly growing interest in birds.

The diverse habitat of our area includes mountains, large lakes, riparian and arid cactus-sage habitats. Thus many different birds are attracted to the area contributing to changing patterns of distribution and new additions to our checklist (440 species as of early September 2016). This checklist was compiled by Brandon Percival and Dave Silverman with the aid of Mark Yaeger, Richard Tucey and Leon Bright.
