

The Arkansas Valley Audubon Society will again sponsor the Pueblo County Fall Migration Count on Saturday, 9-15-18. Anywhere in the County can be birded.

If you wish to join the Greenhorn Valley team, meet 8AM at the Lake Beckwith Dam parking area in Colorado City. We will bird most of the day in the Rye/Colorado City area. Bring lunch if you plan to bird afternoon.

If you plan to bird elsewhere in the County, please let me know at least a week prior to the Count where you will be birding. Doing so will help avoid overlapping coverages. Please submit your lists by email or post with the following information:

- 1) List all species seen & the number of each species seen. Lists submitted in some semblance of checklist order are easiest to compile. Please do not use 4 letter codes such as VIRA for Virginia Rail.
- 2) Submit mileage & hours by car, & mileage & hours on foot listed SEPARATELY. Please do NOT combine.
- 3) List names & emails of all persons who birded with you.

All participants will receive a summary of the Count's highlights. List of all species recorded will be submitted to the ebird/International Migratory Bird Day data base <www.birdday.org>
