

## Wet Mountain Valley's Annual Audubon Field Trip

This year's annual birding field trip sponsored by the Arkansas Valley Audubon chapter will be held Saturday, August 25, 2018. Anyone interested in observing birds in Custer County is invited to participate in this free event. No birding experience is necessary since there are always several expert birders willing to help novices identify the wide variety of birds that will be seen. A pair of binoculars are an essential tool for the experience and a field guide ("bird book") is helpful.
