We saw:

osprey
great blue heron
cormorant
yellow warbler
robin on a nest
bullock's oriole
tree swallow
Western Kingbird
Red-winged Blackbird
Eastern Phoebe
gadwall
Canada Geese
grackles
mourning doves

And **via sound** we picked up these but didn't lay eyes on them:

bewick's wren
common yellowthroat
american goldfinch
warbling vireo
chimney swift
carolina wren
